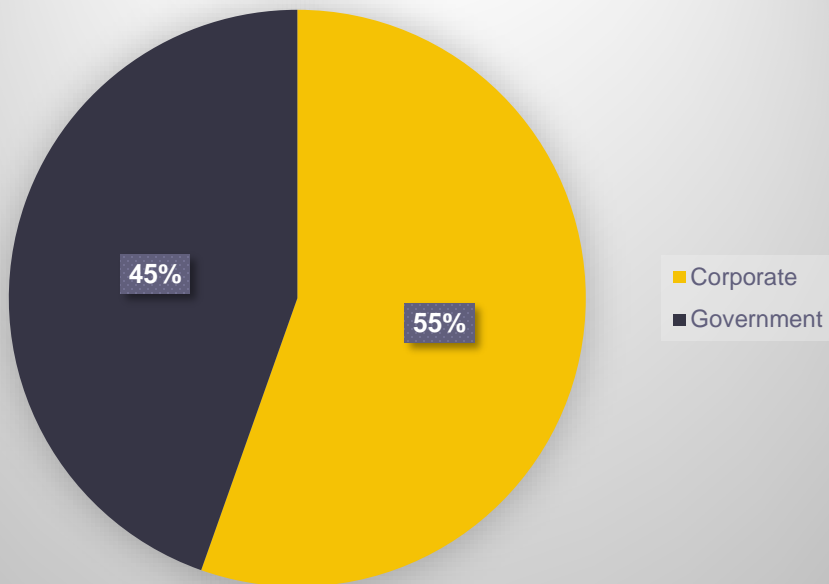

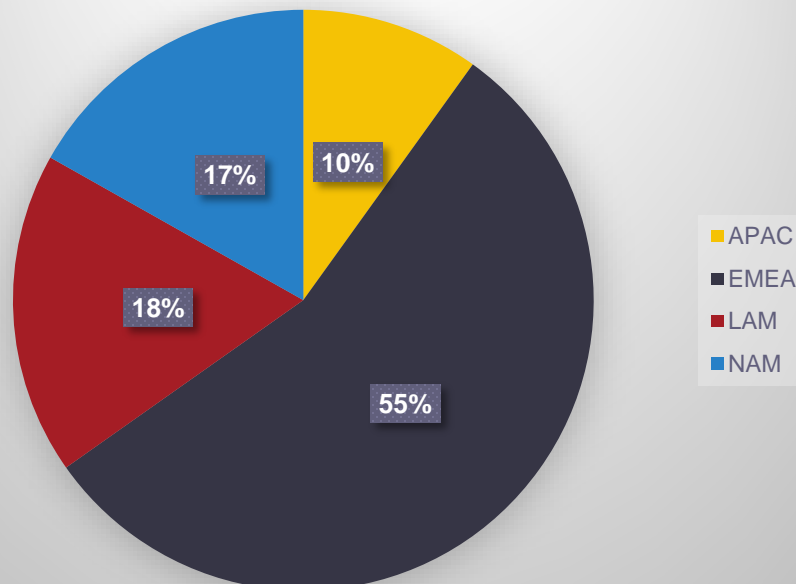

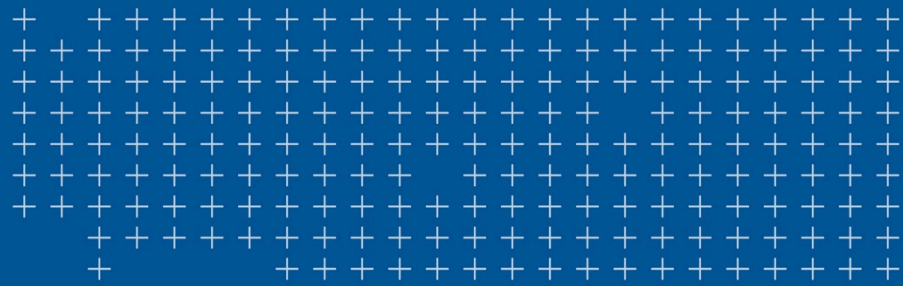
Natural Resources Revenue - 2017

Revenue per Region



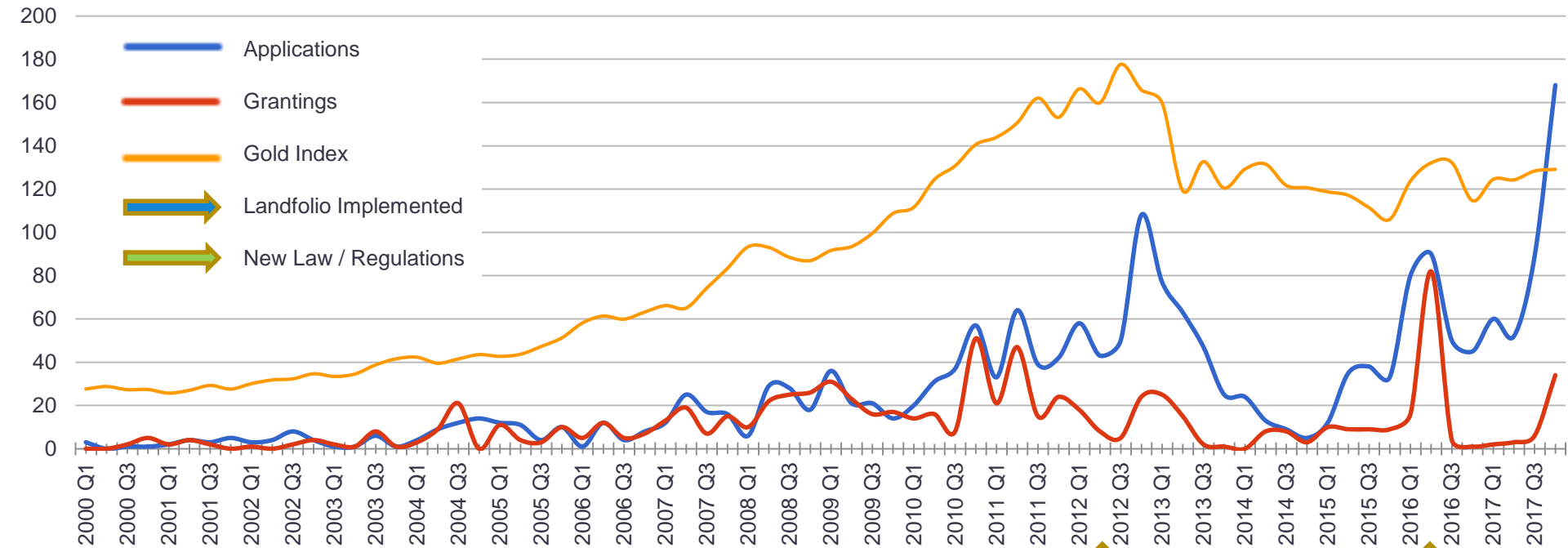

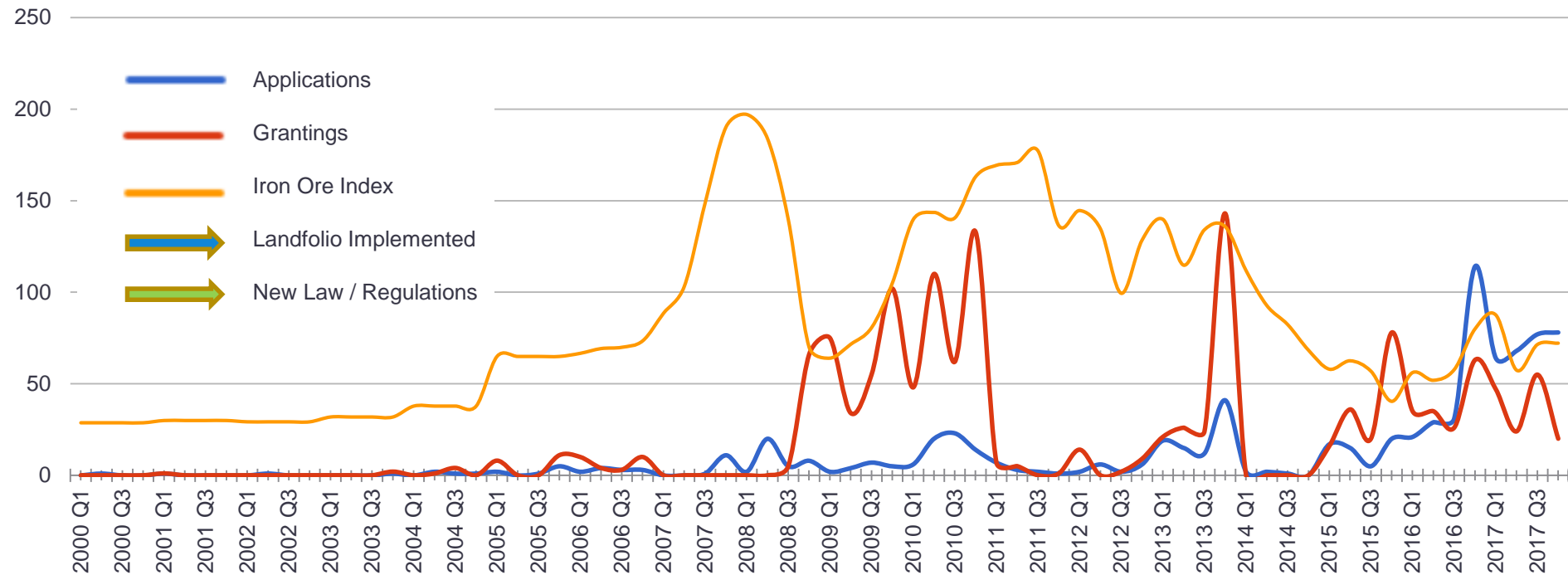

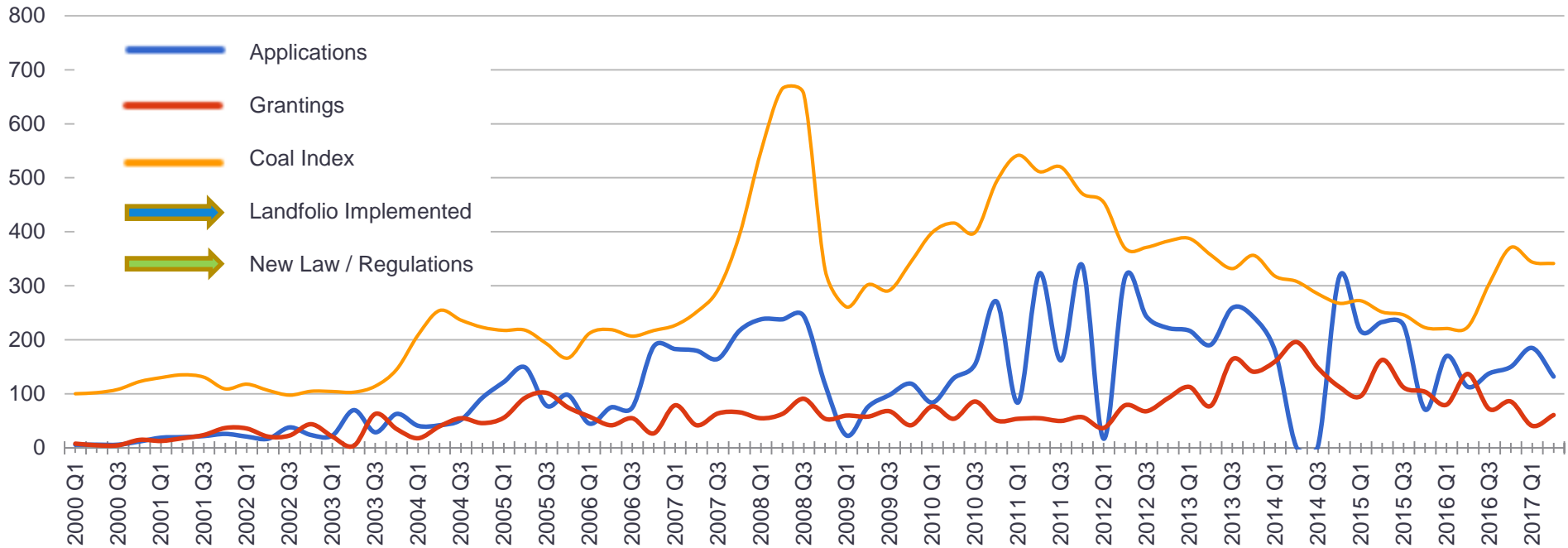
Applications vs Grantings vs Gold



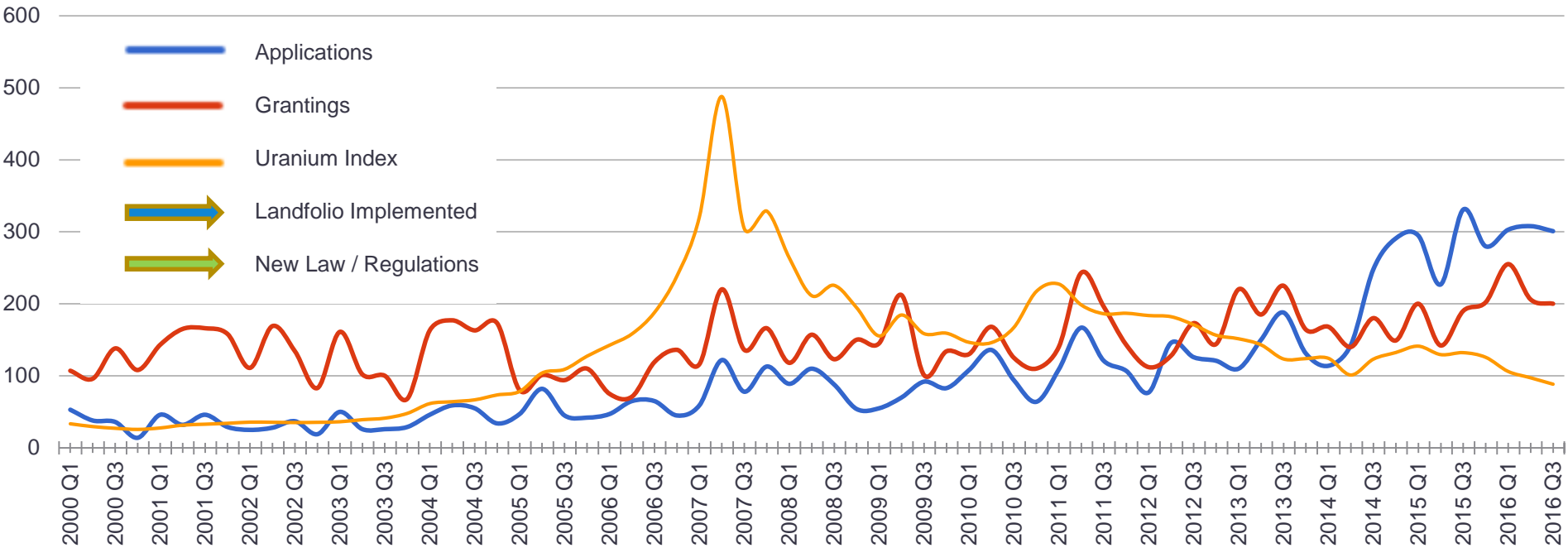
Applications vs Grantings vs Iron Ore



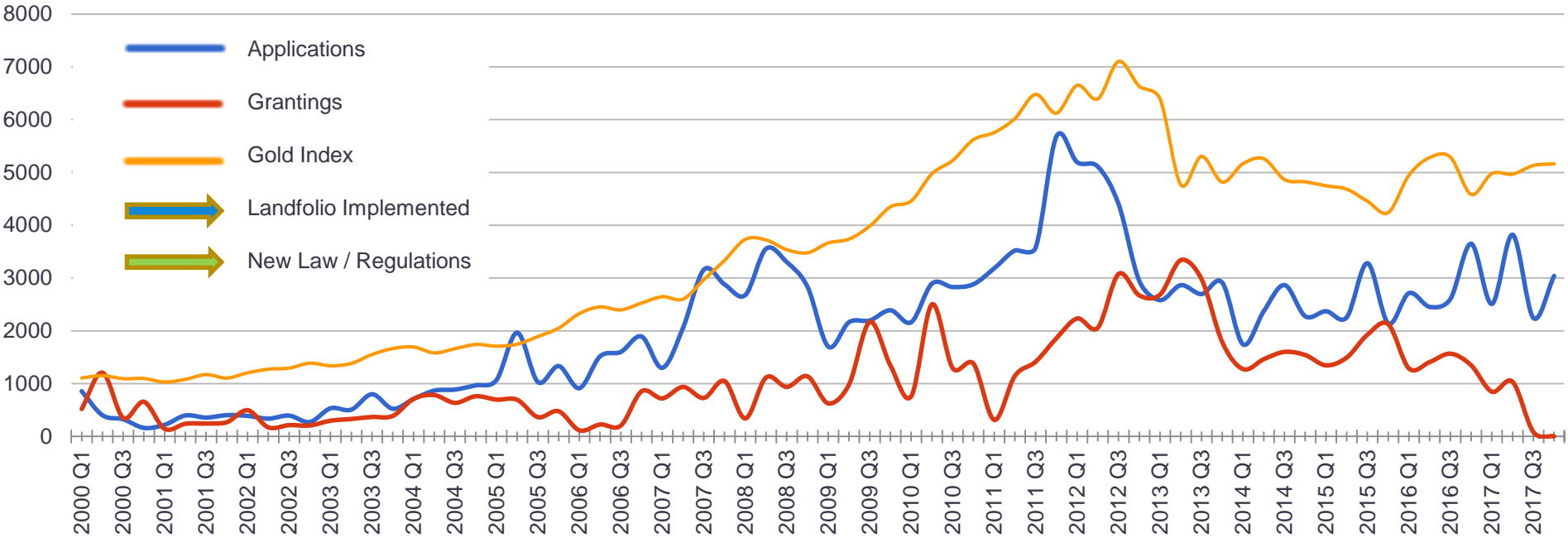
Applications vs Grantings vs Coal
